Project Information:

In conjunction with the Buffalo Fort Erie Peace Bridge Authority and Customs Canada, CKC designed fourteen specialized inspection booths. These booths were designed with the specific intent to maximize the comfort of the Customs Officer. All 14 booths were manufactured, delivered and installed well ahead of schedule.

Features:

- Welded steel frame construction.
- Green tinted reflective glazing to minimize glare.
- Retractable, green tinted, acrylic windbreak to protect Customs Officers.
- Exterior mounted radiant heater over windows.
- Slider door with full-lite slider window. This gives the Officer the flexibility of communicating through the window, or exit the booth, if required.
- Stainless steel work counter and storage drawer.
